

Tribal Youth Health Advisory Board

Eligibility & Criteria

The National Indian Health Board (NIHB) is always working to improve health and reduce health disparities of all 567 federally recognized tribes. To aid NIHB in this effort by participating on the Tribal Youth Health Advisory Board (TYHAB) there are a few basic requirements for applicants:

- Must be a member of a federally recognized Indian Tribe
- Must be between the ages of 18-24
- Must submit a completed [adult recommendation form](#)
- Must be able to attend TYHAB specific meetings, events, and conference calls, etc
- Must show qualities of leadership and be actively engaged in their Tribal community through either school, community organizations, or other roles
- TYHAB members must show qualities of integrity and are expected to be in good standing with their academic institution or place of employment
- Must be prepared to represent themselves, their Tribe, NIHB, and the youth board with honor and respect at a national level
- Must be able and willing to participate in duties as assigned by participating in the TYHAB for a one or two year period
- Must have access to a phone and email account for monthly communications with NIHB staff

The application, including the adult recommendation form will be due at the end of the day January 24th, 2017.
