The American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) of 2009 Communities Putting Prevention to Work (CPPW) funding opportunity through the Department of Health & Human Services and the Centers for Disease Control & Prevention recently announced the extension of the deadline for the required Letter of Intent (LOI). Applicants are required to submit a LOI to be eligible to apply for this funding opportunity.
