
The Circle of Life Initiative was developed in partnership between American Indian/Alaska Native tribes and the American Cancer Society.

Many of you may remember the **Circle Of Life** program from its earliest days as a breast cancer awareness program developed by a dedicated group of American Indians in Oklahoma. Circle Of Life has been revived and expanded to address a broad variety of cancer topics. The American Cancer Society and the Northeast Tribal Cancer Advisory Board are working together to offer a culturally appropriate and tailored educational training specifically for Northeast CHRs and Health Care Providers. Using a holistic health model, this training will be useful for providers, CHRs, program directors, and educators who focus on preventive and primary care. The American Cancer Society will cover the costs of your lodging, food and mileage expenses (at 14 cents per mile) to attend the training.
