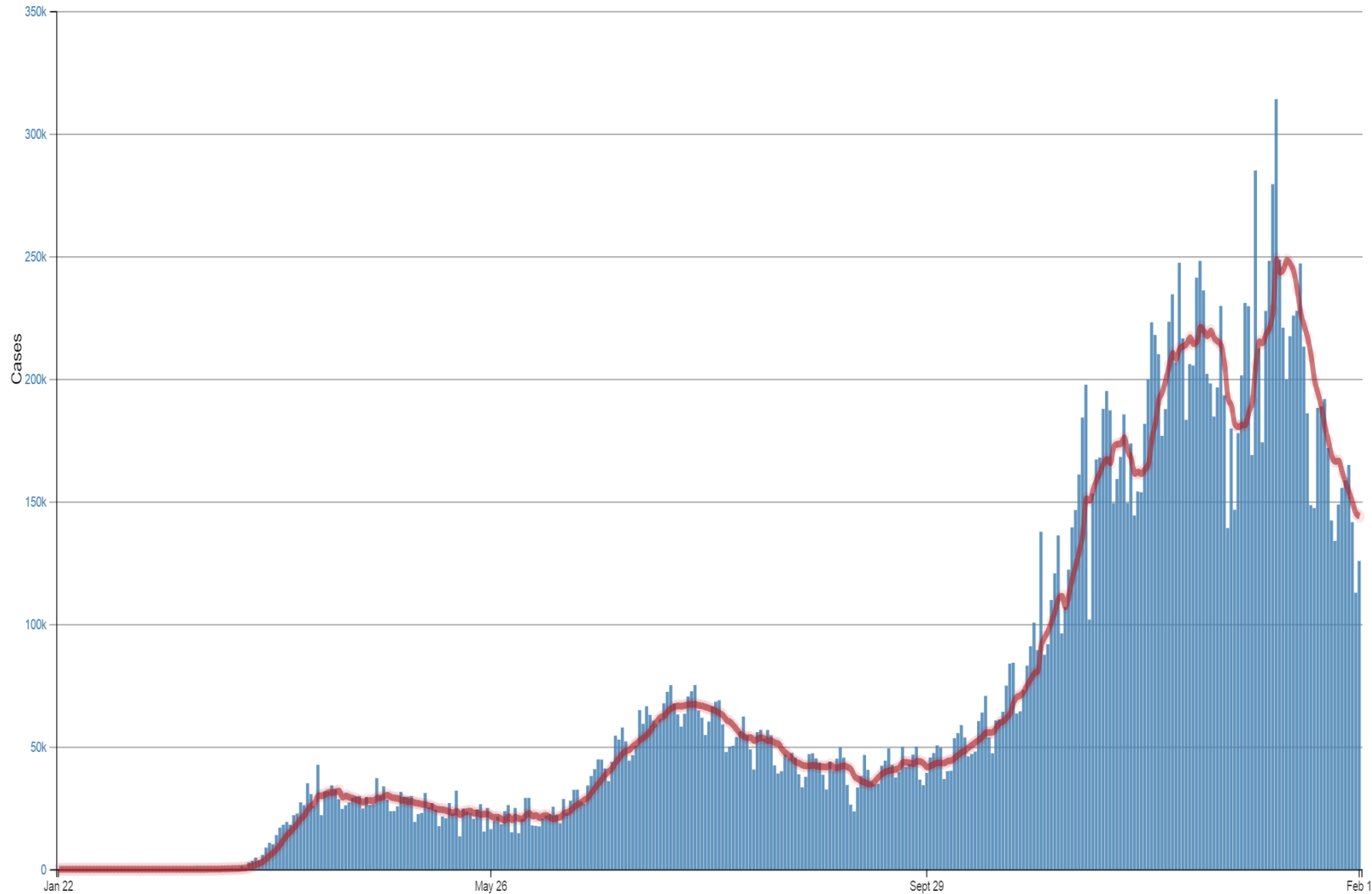

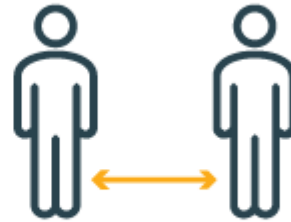

Vaccine Distribution

- Federal allocations to states
- States to COVID-19 vaccine providers
 - **Hospitals**
 - **Local health departments**
 - **Community-based clinics**
- Federal Pharmacy Partnerships
 - **Long-term care facilities** →
 - **Transfer program**
 - **Retail locations**

- **Onsite clinics (3 per facility)**
- **CVS, Walgreens, Managed Health Care Associates, Inc (select pharmacies)**
- **Residents and staff**
- **Free**

Federal Retail Pharmacy Program

- Collaboration: Federal governments, states, 21 national pharmacy groups
- Phased implementation
 - **Small number of stores**
 - **Supply provided by federal government (limited availability initially)**
- Vaccinate priority groups at no cost according to state plan
- States will have visibility on pharmacy locations and vaccine quantity
- Full rollout: 40,000+ pharmacies

 - **Pharmacy website**
 - **State websites**

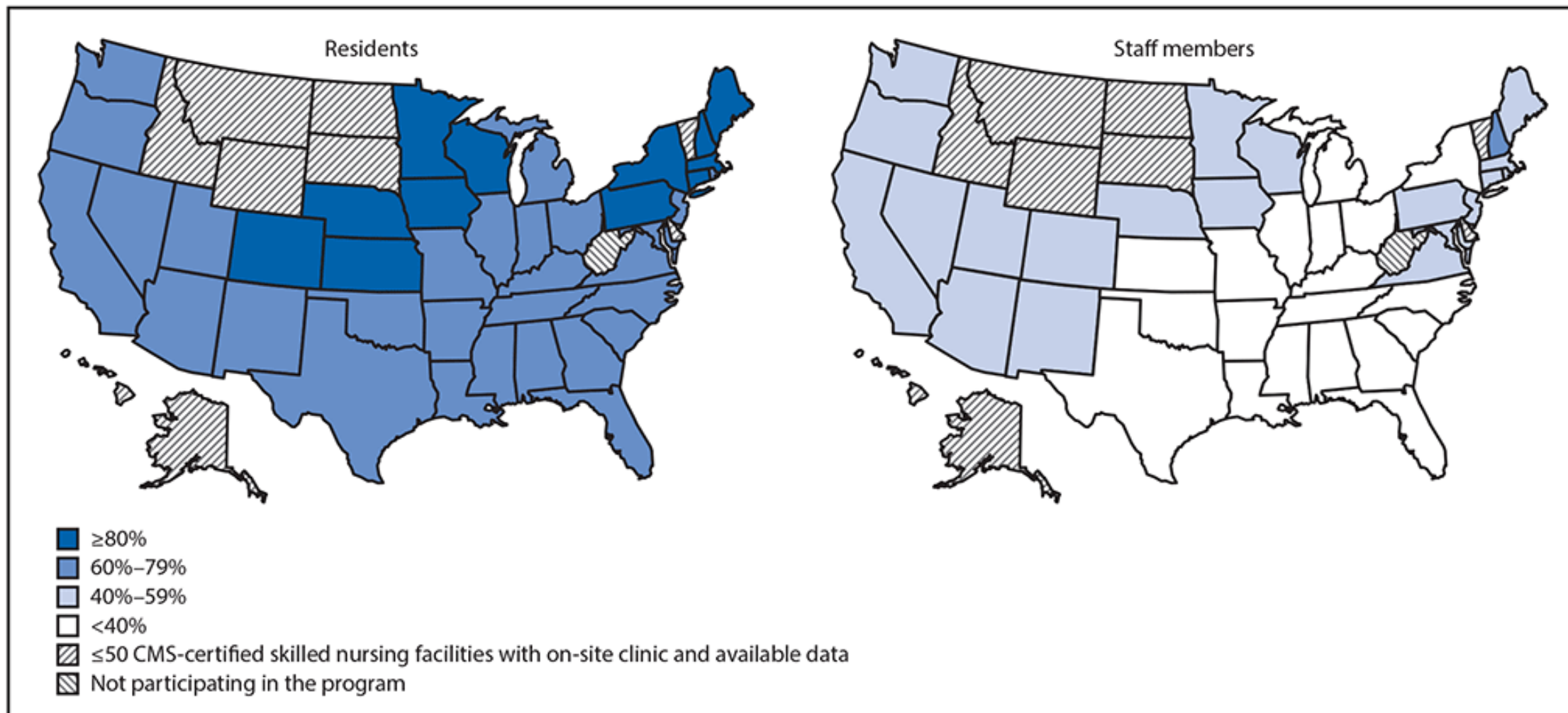

United States, December 2020–January 2021**

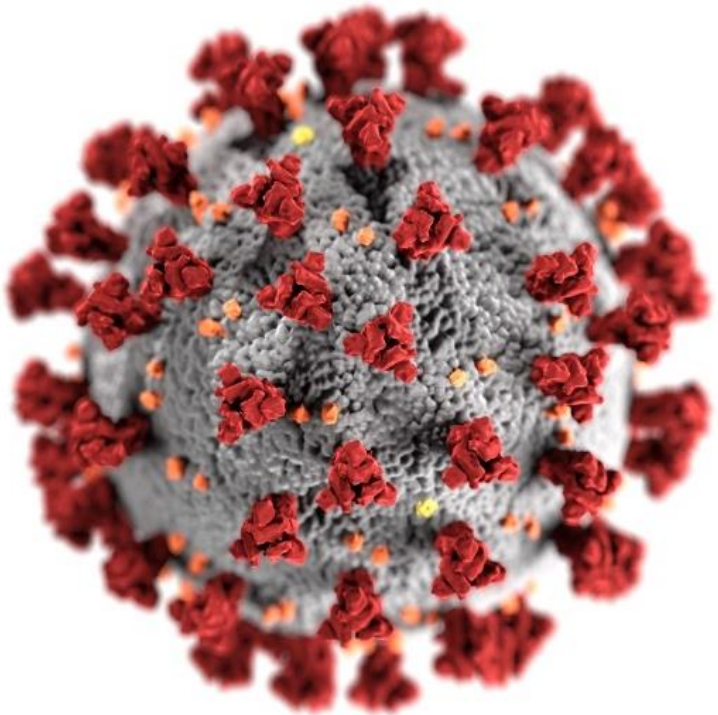
77.8% of residents and 37.5% of staff members received ≥ 1 vaccine dose

- Inpatient use
- May-June: Purchased and allocated by Federal government
- July-current: Allocated by Federal Government, commercially available

Monoclonal Antibodies

- Outpatient use
- November: Purchased and allocated by Federal government
- Multiple mechanisms for healthcare facilities to acquire
